- **Education Freedom**



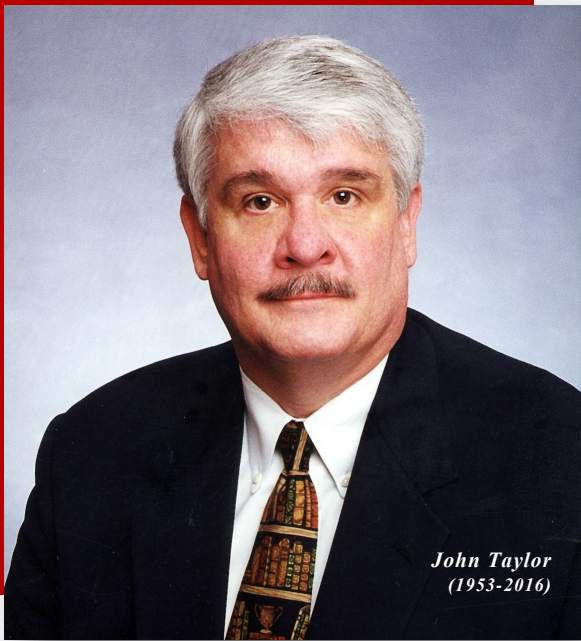

- Repeal of the death tax in Virginia; and,
